### PACKING ORDER

1. Place stove and carpet on side, then wash bins on bottom, then cook kit into washbins.
2. Place smaller articles around for best fit. Stand up soap/bleach/sponge container on box bottom.
3. Place plastic pasta strainer on top, then griddle face down.
4. **PACK EVERYTHING 100% DRY.** A wet sponge will cause mildew, dry it out after a campout!
