



## TROOP 944 QUARTERMASTER

### Position Description Summary

- You are a LEADER. Set a good example by wearing full uniform, attending meetings and campouts, showing Scout spirit and living the Scout Oath and Scout Law.
- You will officially report to the ASPL as he is your functional leader, but the Adult QM will work directly with you the most.
- Attend Youth Leader Training (YLT); **required for leadership credit.**
- Distribute and collect equipment to Patrols during equipment distribution sessions. Participate in 2 or more distribution or collection sessions (about 1/2 hr. each). **Required for leadership credit.**
- Participate in at least one (of three) troop inventory and repair sessions (3 hrs. each); **required for leadership credit.** Two may be beneficial depending on performance level in other areas.
- Attend scheduled training sessions or on-the-job training sessions.
- Help keep track of troop equipment and sees that it is in good working order. Help the Adult QM and Patrol QMs by assisting in repair, cleaning, inventory, or purchasing.
- Distribute and collect equipment "on demand" when requested by Patrol QMs.
- Make recommendations for new equipment or repairs to the SPL, ASPL, or PLC meeting.
- Participate in how-to sessions during scout meetings to demonstrate how to set up tents, pack and clean chuck boxes, set up the canopy, etc.
- Demonstrate quick "equipment tips" during meetings (when instructed by the adult QM).
- Demonstrate proper use and care of equipment on campouts, especially to the new Scouts. Actively check for proper tent set up, proper canopy set up, etc. Report abuse to the ASPL or SPL.
- **Important.** Record your service and attendance on your leadership tracking form and have the Adult QM sign off on this at the end of the term. Leadership credit is awarded on overall performance in addition to meeting the mandatory requirements highlighted above.
