

# TROOP 944 SUMMER CAMP

## Mountaineer Scout Reservation



July 8-14, 2018

Full Fee due to Troop April 4



### Deposit of \$100 per Scout due February 28

Fee Due	<u>April 4</u>	<u>after April 4, if available</u>
Scouts	\$345	\$395 (includes deposit, remainder \$245 & \$295)

Fee is transferable to another Scout in Unit; no refunds are available. Campsite planning is made on January numbers; this can affect number of Scouts able to register later due to campsite capacity. AOL --> New Scouts do not need to pay the deposit, just the correct fee. Troop will have Summer Camp meeting for new parents on May 2. A camp Activity Shirt is included with the Scout fee; adults will need to pay separately.

**Adults** Adult fees are \$100 per week due April 4, (no day rate, leaders may share week)

Make checks out to Troop 944, and give to Chip Galloway. Note, there is no partial payment schedule; a deposit and full-fee is required to hold the space. Both Scouts and Adults **MUST** have medical-physicals on BSA Annual Health & Medical Record Form to Troop by April 4 (or give date of physical to the Troop).

The camp is run by the Troop/Patrol Method for all activities. All Scouts and adults/leaders on site must be registered/insured with BSA. Adults must have in-date Youth Protection Training.

New Scouts (and some Scouts under First Class) will participate in the "**Mountain Man**" program for rapid rank advancement.

### Preliminary List of Merit Badges Offered:

**Aquatics:** Kayaking, Rowing, Canoeing, Swimming, Lifesaving

**Scoutcraft:** Pioneering, Camping, Orienteering, Geocaching, Wilderness Survival

**Shooting Sports:** Archery, Rifle, Shotgun

**Handicraft:** Basketry, Leatherwork, Indian Lore, Wood Carving

**Ecology:** Nature, Fishing Environmental Science, Forestry, Geology, Insect Study, Fish & Wildlife Mgt, Leave no Trace (program not MB)

**Trail to Eagle:** First Aid, Emergency Prep, Citizenship in the Nation

**Other** Space Exploration, Climbing, Cycling

Additional Merit Badges & activities may be added later.

### HIGH ADVENTURE:

Special High Adventure Programs for older Scouts including **COPE**, Climbing (60 ft hex tower), Fishing, Mile Swim, Zip Line (330 ft) & duel ¼ mile zip line. [High Adventure Program-- off-site camping most of the week (from Mountaineer as base) for older Scouts (age 13) including spelunking, whitewater rafting, canoeing, climbing, and shooting sports -- \$100 extra cost each, but must have minimum 6 Scouts & 2 adults (crew max is 10). Scouts will not take camp Merit Badges and other activities.]
